**PLEASE READ ALL REQUIREMENTS. POSTMARK DEADLINE IS APRIL 1**

1. Application must be postmarked no later than April 1.
2. Applicant must:
  - a. Be a resident of Warren County.
  - b. Be a dependent of a Warren County Water District Customer.
  - c. Be graduating from Greenwood High School, South Warren High School, Warren East High School, Warren Central High School, Bowling Green High Schools, home school, private school or any future public school in Warren County.
  - d. Enroll at Western Kentucky University or SKYCTC.
  - e. Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0.
  - f. Complete a current FAFSA report.
  - g. Seek a degree in one of the following fields of study:
    - o Engineering
    - o Environmental Science
    - o Biology
    - o Chemistry
    - o Architectural & Manufacturer Sciences (Drafting or AutoCAD)
    - o Agriculture
    - o Public Health
    - o Business
    - o Accounting
    - o Water Utilities Management
  - h. Maintain one of the required fields of study throughout their post-secondary academic career to remain eligible.
3. Students who receive scholarships from other sources with total amounts equal to full tuition or above will not be eligible for the WCWD Scholarship.
4. Relatives of the WCWD staff and board will not be eligible for this scholarship.
